General Business

1. The Hi Points competition was re-introduced this season. A few tweaks in the rules will need to be made but otherwise was successful. Entries still open until 8th August.
2. The Field Hunter competition for 2025 entries are still open. 2 photos of a Pinto in the hunting field jumping to be submitted. To be judged by a suitable non-Pinto member.
3. Colouring competition for kids had no entries. Will not run this next season.
4. Photo competition was very popular and had lots of entries. Will run again next season.
5. Committee to encourage registered stallions to advertise on the website.
6. Committee will need to review the Societies constitution to ensure it meets the new rules being introduced in 2025. A Special General meeting will be required to change or add more rules if required. Julie still updating constitution.
7. Zoe Charles and Katrina Gosney attended the RAS conference. It was noted that for the cost to attend this conference it is probably not worth the cost unless our Society has a direct remit, they which to discuss.
8. Katrina Gosney discussed that at Oxford A&P show 2025 the Inhand and Ridden Pinto went up against each other for Supreme. This is not ideal, will follow up with the show to find out if this was because it was a Royal show or an ongoing issue.
