INFORMATION

- Plaiting is optional
- Back numbers are to be supplied by the competitor
- The show programme will be emailed
- You can choose to enter your horse in either Heavyweight, Lightweight or Middleweight
- Age of horse is recognised as 1st August
- Age of the Rider or Handler is as of the date of the show
- The NZ Pinto Horse Society Committee reserves the right to alter or delete the programme as they see fit

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. This show is for Pinto horses only (excluding the Registered Gypsy Cob classes). Horses MUST be registered and the owner a financial member of the NZ Pinto Horse Society at close of entries
2. No trimming of horse's whiskers or inner ear is permitted. Refer <https://www.nzequestrian.org.nz/wp-content/uploads/PP-GR-132.pdf> as a guide
3. It is recommended you have a current Life or NZ RAS Height Certificate for the 2024/2025 Show Season.
Led Youngstock Horses to mature over 148cm (2 years & under) do not require them
No measuring available on the day
Failure to produce a current certificate if asked may result in elimination with no refund
4. ALL riders must wear protective head gear, which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at two or more points at all times while riding
5. **Colts and Stallions**
ALL Colts or Stallions 12 months and over, must be shown in a bridle and bit and Miniature horses in a halter and chain

To wear 2 official 'S' identification badges, one attached to each side of their bridle or halter at all times.
Handlers and Riders must also wear two RAS official armbands (one on each arm) when in the ring

Pony Stallions must be ridden by riders 14 years & over also refer Novice pony rule. Stallions over 148cm must be led or ridden by a rider 17 years of age or older

No colts or stallions are to be left unattended or tied to floats/trucks at any time while on the show grounds

An official can order any stallion or colt considered out of control or to be causing undue disquiet to other horses from the ring without recourse from the stallion or colts owner/exhibitor/competitor.

Colts or stallions will be eliminated with no refund given if the above rule is not adhered to
6. **Green Pony/Horse**
Must NOT have won a 1st in a Pinto conformation class or Best Registered Pinto class at close of entries at any RAS affiliated show, Horse of the Year show or NZ Pinto Horse Society show at close of entries
7. **Novice**
Not to have won more than 5 wins in a Pinto conformation class or Best Registered Pinto class. Novice wins include all RAS affiliated shows, Horse of the Year and NZ Pinto Horse Society shows at close of entries

Novices are eligible to enter Open classes

Novice Ponies can be ridden by riders over 17 years in the Novice class only. They are not eligible for the Open Championship if ridden by a rider over 17 years of age
8. **Open Ponies** must be ridden by riders 17 years and under in all classes.
9. Protests must be accompanied by a \$50 deposit, refundable if the protest is sustained and submitted no later than half an hour after the incident that gave rise to the protest
10. Any competitor or spectator found mistreating a horse, competing a horse deemed to be lame by the judge, arguing/fighting or being abusive to other competitors, judges or officials will be eliminated with no refund and asked to leave the grounds immediately. This includes ringside behaviour

11. In the event of sickness or injury, 75% of total entry fees will be refunded if a qualified Veterinarian or Doctors certificate is produced to the Show Secretary within 5 working days of the competition. No other refunds will be made
12. NZ Pinto Horse Society accepts no responsibility for injury, loss or damage to Property, Horse, Handler, Rider or Spectator
13. Any Lapels, Badges, Rugs or similar that identify previous awards won are banned from being worn on the rider/handler or horse/pony in or near the ring
14. Yards must be left clean. **ALL manure/hay must be picked up and placed in designated area from yards and around floats etc**
15. **Supreme Winners Prize Money**
The NZ Pinto Horse Society offers \$700 for the **Supreme Inhand winner** and \$700 for the **Supreme Ridden winner** with a cap of \$1000 if the same horse wins both. The prize is only given if the horse competes in the Pinto section at the Horse of the Year Show (HOY) 2025 in a minimum of 3 classes

The full prize money amount applies to South Island horses only, if you reside in the North Island the prize money decreases depending on the distance you live from the HOY showgrounds

A copy of the receipt of your HOY entry must be provided to the Society Secretary. Payment will be made within 5 days after the completion of HOY 2025. Not transferable to any other horse or if the horse is sold. If the horse entered doesn't compete on the day or if HOY 2025 is cancelled the prize will not be paid unless the committee decides otherwise. If prize is not claimed by 1st March 2025 the prize is forfeited

2. Handler 17 years & under leading any weight Pinto
3. Best Colour & Pattern *judged on markings exhibited only*
4. Best Walking
5. Best Trotting
6. Foal or Yearling to mature over 148cm, *1st placegetter to go forward for Champion Youngstock at end of the section*
7. 2 or 3 year old to mature over 148cm, *1st placegetter to go forward for Champion Youngstock at end of the section*
8. Pony 3 years & under, to mature under 148cm, *1st placegetter to go forward for Champion Youngstock at end of the section*
9. Pony 4 years & over, not to exceed 148cm
10. Adult 4 years & over, over 148cm but not to exceed 158cm
11. Adult 4 years & over, over 158cm

Champion & Reserve Adult Heavyweight judged from 1st placegetters in classes 10 & 11, 2nd placegetters to stand by

Champion & Reserve Pony – judged from 1st placegetters in classes 9 & 22, 2nd placegetters to stand by

Champion winners to go forward for **Supreme of Show** at end of the Inhand section

BEST REGISTERED INHAND GYPSY COB Solid Coloured or Pinto

Gypsy Cobs must be registered with the NZGCA or any foals born after 1 August 2024 must be eligible for registration with the NZGCA, and the owner must be a current financial member of the NZGCA to enter classes 12 and 13. Open to solid coloured and Pinto horses. NZGCA HOY 2025 qualifying classes

12. Best Registered Purebred Gypsy Cob any height *sash donated by the NZGCA*
13. Best Registered Partbred Gypsy Cob any height *sash donated by the NZGCA*

INHAND LIGHTWEIGHT AND MIDDLEWEIGHT PINTO any height

Lightweight is a finer type of Horse

Middleweight is a Riding Horse type

14. Best Presented Pinto & Handler, *1st placegetter to go forward for Champion Best Presented*
15. Handler 18 years & over leading any weight Pinto
16. Best Colour & Pattern *judged on markings exhibited only*
17. Best Walking
18. Best Trotting
19. Foal or Yearling to mature over 148cm, *1st placegetter to go forward for Champion Youngstock at end of the section*
20. 2 or 3 year old to mature over 148cm, *1st placegetter to go forward for Champion Youngstock at end of the section*
21. Pony 3 years & under, to mature under 148cm, *1st placegetter to go forward for Champion Youngstock at end of the section*
22. Pony 4 years & over, not to exceed 148cm
23. Adult Lightweight 4 years & over, over 148cm
24. Adult Middleweight 4 years & over, over 148cm

Champion & Reserve Lightweight/Middleweight judged from 1st placegetters in classes 23 & 24, 2nd placegetters to stand by

Champion & Reserve Pony judged from 1st placegetters in classes 9 & 22, 2nd placegetters to stand by

Champion Youngstock judged from Youngstock winners from classes 6, 7, 8, 19, 20 & 21

After completion of the Inhand sections

RIDDEN SECTION

Approximately 30 minutes will be given from judging of Supreme of Show to the start of the Ridden sections

RIDDEN HEAVYWEIGHT PINTO any height

Heavyweight is a heavier horse e.g. Saddle Hunter or Cob type

25. Best Presented Pinto & Rider, *1st placegetter to go forward for Champion Best Presented*
26. Rider 17 years & under, riding any weight Pinto
27. Green Heavyweight any height, walking & trotting only
28. Best Paced any height – *1st place getters go forward for Champion & Reserve Paced and Mannered*
29. Best Mannered any height – *1st place getters go forward for Champion & Reserve Paced and Mannered*
30. Novice Pony 0 to 5 wins not to exceed 148cm, *1st placegetter to go forward for Champion Novice*

31. Novice Heavyweight 0 to 5 wins over 148cm, *1st placegetter to go forward for Champion Novice*
32. Open Pony not to exceed 148cm
33. Open Heavyweight over 148cm but not to exceed 158cm
34. Open Heavyweight over 158cm

Champion & Reserve Heavyweight judged from 1st placegetters in class 33 & 34, 2nd placegetter to stand by
Champion winner receives a Memorial Trophy sponsored by Viana Fallaver

Champion & Reserve Pony judged from 1st placegetters in class 32 & 43, 2nd placegetters to stand by

BEST REGISTERED RIDDEN GYPSY COB Solid Coloured or Pinto

Gypsy Cobs must be registered with the NZGCA and the owner must be a current financial member of the NZGCA to enter classes 35 and 36. Open to solid coloured and Pinto horses. NZGCA HOY 2025 qualifying classes

35. Best Registered Purebred Gypsy Cob any height, *sash donated by the NZGCA, judged as an Open class*
36. Best Registered Partbred Gypsy Cob any height, *sash donated by the NZGCA, judged as an Open class*

RIDDEN LIGHTWEIGHT AND MIDDLEWEIGHT PINTO any height

Lightweight is a finer type of Horse

Middleweight is a Riding Horse type

37. Best Presented Pinto & Rider, *1st placegetters to go forward for Champion Best Presented*
38. Rider 18 years & over, riding any weight Pinto
39. Green Horse any height, walking & trotting only
40. Best Paced any height – *1st place getters go forward for Champion & Reserve Paced and Mannered*
41. Best Mannered any height – *1st place getters go forward for Champion & Reserve Paced and Mannered*
42. Novice Pony 0 to 5 wins not to exceed 148cm, *1st placegetter to go forward for Champion Novice*
43. Novice 0 to 5 wins over 148cm, *1st placegetter to go forward for Champion Novice*
44. Open Pony not to exceed 148cm
45. Open Lightweight over 148cm
46. Open Middleweight over 148cm

Champion & Reserve Lightweight/Middleweight judged from 1st placegetters in class 45 & 46, 2nd placegetters to stand by

Champion & Reserve Pony judged from 1st placegetters in class 32 & 44, 2nd placegetters to stand by

After completion of the Ridden sections

Champion & Reserve Novice judged from 1st placegetters in classes 30, 31, 42 & 43, 2nd placegetters to stand by

Champion & Reserve Paced & Mannered, Kindly Sponsored by Alice Hamer judged from 1st placegetters in classes 28, 29, 40 & 41, 2nd placegetters to stand by
