## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- (1) This show is for Pinto horses only. Horses **MUST** be registered & the owner a financial member of the NZ Pinto Horse Society at close of entries
- (2) Plaiting Optional
- (3) **No** trimming of horses whiskers or inner ear is permitted. Refer <https://www.nzequestrian.org.nz/wp-content/uploads/PP-GR-132.pdf> as a guide.
- (4) Back numbers are to be supplied by the competitor. **NO** back numbers available on the day. All Show Programmes are emailed
- (5) Age of horse is recognised as 1<sup>st</sup> August. Age of Rider/Handler as of date of the show
- (6) It is recommended you have a current Life or NZ RAS Height Certificate for the 2021/2022 Show Season. **Led Youngstock Horses to mature over 148cm (2 years & under) do not require them.** No measuring available on the day. Failure to produce a current certificate if asked may result in elimination with no refund
- (7) **ALL** riders must wear protective head gear, which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at two or more points at all times while riding
- (8) **ALL** Colts/Stallions – 12 months & over. Must be shown in a bridle & bit. Miniatures in a halter & chain To wear 2 official 'S' identification badges, one attached to each side of their bridle/halter at all times. Handlers & Riders must also wear two RAS official armbands (one on each arm) when in the ring  
Pony Stallions must be ridden by riders 14 years & over also refer Novice pony rule. Stallions over 148cm must be led or ridden by a rider 17 years of age or older  
No colts/stallions are to be left unattended or tied to floats/trucks at any time while on the show grounds  
An official can order any stallion/colt considered out of control or to be causing undue disquiet to other horses from the ring without recourse from the stallion/colt's owner/exhibitor/competitor  
**Colts/stallions will be eliminated with no refund given if the above rule is not adhered to**

- (9) Green Pony/Horse Must NOT have won a 1<sup>st</sup> in a Pinto conformation class or Best Registered Pinto class at close of entries at all RAS affiliated shows, Premier show, HOY & NZ Pinto Horse Soc Shows at close of entries
- (10) Novice has not had more than 5 wins in a Pinto conformation class or Best Registered Pinto class. Novice wins include all RAS affiliated shows, Premier show, HOY & NZ Pinto Horse Soc Shows at close of entries. Novices are eligible to enter Open classes
- (11) Novice Ponies can be ridden by riders over 17 years in all the classes excluding Open. They are not eligible for the Open Championship if ridden by a rider over 17 years of age. **Open** ponies must be ridden by riders 17 years & under in all classes. No change of rider is allowed once the section has started
- (12) Protests must be accompanied by a \$50 deposit, refundable if the protest is sustained & submitted no later than half an hour after the incident that gave rise to the protest
- (13) No Dogs permitted on the grounds, failure to comply will result in disqualification with no refund
- (14) The NZPtHS Committee reserves the right to alter/delete the programme as they see fit
- (15) Any competitor or spectator found mistreating a horse, competing a horse deemed to be lame by the judge, arguing/fighting or being abusive to other competitors, judges or officials will be eliminated with no refund & asked to leave the grounds immediately. This includes ringside behaviour
- (16) In the event of sickness or injury, 75% of total entry fees will be refunded if a qualified Veterinarian or Doctors certificate ONLY is produced to the Show Secretary within 5 working days of the competition. No other refunds will be made
- (17) NZPtHS accept no responsibility for injury, loss or damage to Property, Horse, Handler/Rider or Spectator
- (18) \$700 for Supreme of Show Inhand winner & \$700 Supreme Ridden winner with a cap of \$1000 for one horse, if they are competing at the HOY show 2022 in the Pinto section. The \$700 applies to South Island horses only, if you reside in the NI the prize money decreases depending the distance you live from HOY grounds. A copy of the receipt of your HOY entry must be provided to the Society Secretary. Payment will be made within 5 days after the completion of HOY 2022. Not transferable to any other horse. If the horse entered doesn't compete on the day the prize will not be paid unless the committee decides otherwise. If prize is not claimed by 1<sup>st</sup> March 2022 prize is forfeited.
- (19) Any Lapels, Badges, Rugs or similar that identify previous awards won are banned from being worn on the rider/handler or horse/pony in or near the ring
- (20) Yards must be left clean. **ALL manure/hay must be picked up and placed in designated area from yards and around floats etc.**
- (21) Gypsy Cob classes - horses must be registered with the NZGCA or any foals born after 1 August 2021 must be eligible for registration with the NZGCA, and the owner must be a current financial member of the NZGCA. Open to solid coloured and Pinto horses. These are NZGCA HOY 2022 qualifying classes
- (22) You can choose to enter your horse into either Heavyweight or Lightweight/Middleweight Pinto not both.

**Heavyweight is a heavier horse e.g. Saddle Hunter or Cob type**

1. Best Presented Pinto & Handler, *1<sup>st</sup> placegetter to go forward for Champion Best Presented*
2. Handler 17 years & under leading any weight Pinto
3. Best Colour & Pattern *judged on markings exhibited only*
4. Best Walking
5. Best Trotting
6. Foal or Yearling to mature over 148cm, *1<sup>st</sup> placegetter to go forward for Champion Youngstock at end of the section*
7. 2 or 3 year old to mature over 148cm, *1<sup>st</sup> placegetter to go forward for Champion Youngstock at end of the section*
8. Pony 3 years & under, to mature under 148cm, *1<sup>st</sup> placegetter to go forward for Champion Youngstock at end of the section*
9. Pony 4 years & over, not to exceed 148cm
10. Adult 4 years & over, over 148cm but not to exceed 158cm
11. Adult 4 years & over, over 158cm

**Champion & Reserve Adult Heavyweight Pinto** judged from 1<sup>st</sup> placegetters in classes 10 & 11, 2<sup>nd</sup> placegetters to stand by

**Champion & Reserve Pony** – judged from 1<sup>st</sup> place getters in classes 9 & 21

**Champion winners** to go forward for Supreme of Show at end of the Inhand section

## REGISTERED GYPSY COB Solid or Pinto

12. Best Purebred Gypsy Cob any height *Champion & Reserve sashes donated by the NZGCA*
13. Best Partbred Gypsy Cob any height *Champion & Reserve sashes donated by the NZGCA*

## INHAND LIGHTWEIGHT/MIDDLEWEIGHT PINTO any height

**Middleweight is a Riding Horse type**

14. Best Presented Pinto & Handler, *1<sup>st</sup> placegetter to go forward for Champion Best Presented*
15. Handler 18 years & over leading any weight Pinto
16. Best Walking
17. Best Trotting
18. Foal or Yearling to mature over 148cm, *1<sup>st</sup> placegetter to go forward for Champion Youngstock at end of the section*
19. 2 or 3 year old to mature over 148cm, *1<sup>st</sup> placegetter to go forward for Champion Youngstock at end of the section*
20. Pony 3 years & under, to mature under 148cm, *1<sup>st</sup> placegetter to go forward for Champion Youngstock at end of the section*
21. Pony 4 years & over, not to exceed 148cm
22. Adult Lightweight 4 years & over, over 148cm
23. Adult Middleweight 4 years & over, over 148cm

**Champion & Reserve Lightweight/Middleweight** judged from 1<sup>st</sup> placegetters in classes 22 & 23, 2<sup>nd</sup> placegetters to stand by

**Champion & Reserve Pony** judged from 1<sup>st</sup> place getters in classes 9 & 21

**Youngstock Champion** judged from Youngstock winners from classes – 6, 7, 8, 18, 19 & 20

After completion of the Inhand sections **SUPREME OF SHOW** judged from all Inhand Champion winners

25. Rider 17 years & under riding any weight Pinto
26. Green Heavyweight any height, walking & trotting only
27. Best Paced any height
28. Best Mannered any height
29. Novice Pony 0 to 5 wins not to exceed 148cm, *1<sup>st</sup> placegetter to go forward for Champion Novice*
30. Novice Heavyweight 0 to 5 wins over 148cm, *1<sup>st</sup> placegetter to go forward for Champion Novice*
31. Open Pony not to exceed 148cm
32. Open Heavyweight over 148cm

**Champion & Reserve Heavyweight Pinto** (memorial trophy sponsored by Viana Fallaver), judged from 1<sup>st</sup> placegetters in classes 30 & 32, 2<sup>nd</sup> placegetter to stand by

**Champion & Reserve Pony** judged from 1<sup>st</sup> placegetters in classes 29, 31, 40 & 42, 2<sup>nd</sup> placegetters to stand by

37. Green Horse any height, walking & trotting only
38. Best Paced any height

40. Novice Pony 0 to 5 wins not to exceed 148cm, *1<sup>st</sup> placegetter to go forward for Champion Novice*
41. Novice 0 to 5 wins over 148cm, *1<sup>st</sup> placegetter to go forward for Champion Novice*
42. Open Pony not to exceed 148cm
43. Open Lightweight over 148cm
44. Open Middleweight over 148cm

**Champion & Reserve Lightweight/Middleweight** judged from 1<sup>st</sup> placegetters in classes 41, 43 & 44, 2<sup>nd</sup> placegetters to stand by

**Champion & Reserve Pony** judged from 1<sup>st</sup> placegetters in classes 29, 31, 40 & 42, 2<sup>nd</sup> placegetters to stand by

After completion of the Open Ridden sections **Champion & Reserve Novice** judged from 1<sup>st</sup> placegetters in classes 29, 30, 40 & 41

After completion of the Open Ridden sections **SUPREME OF SHOW** judged from all Ridden Champion winners
